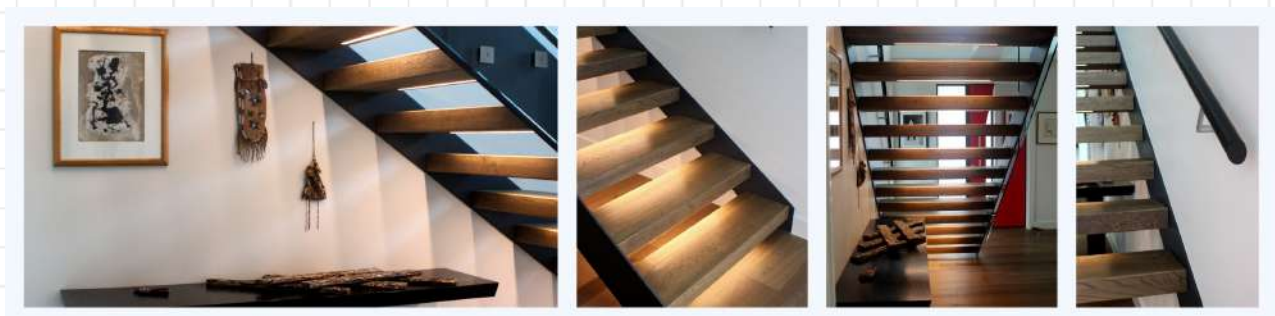


LUXURY HOUSE BUILD
